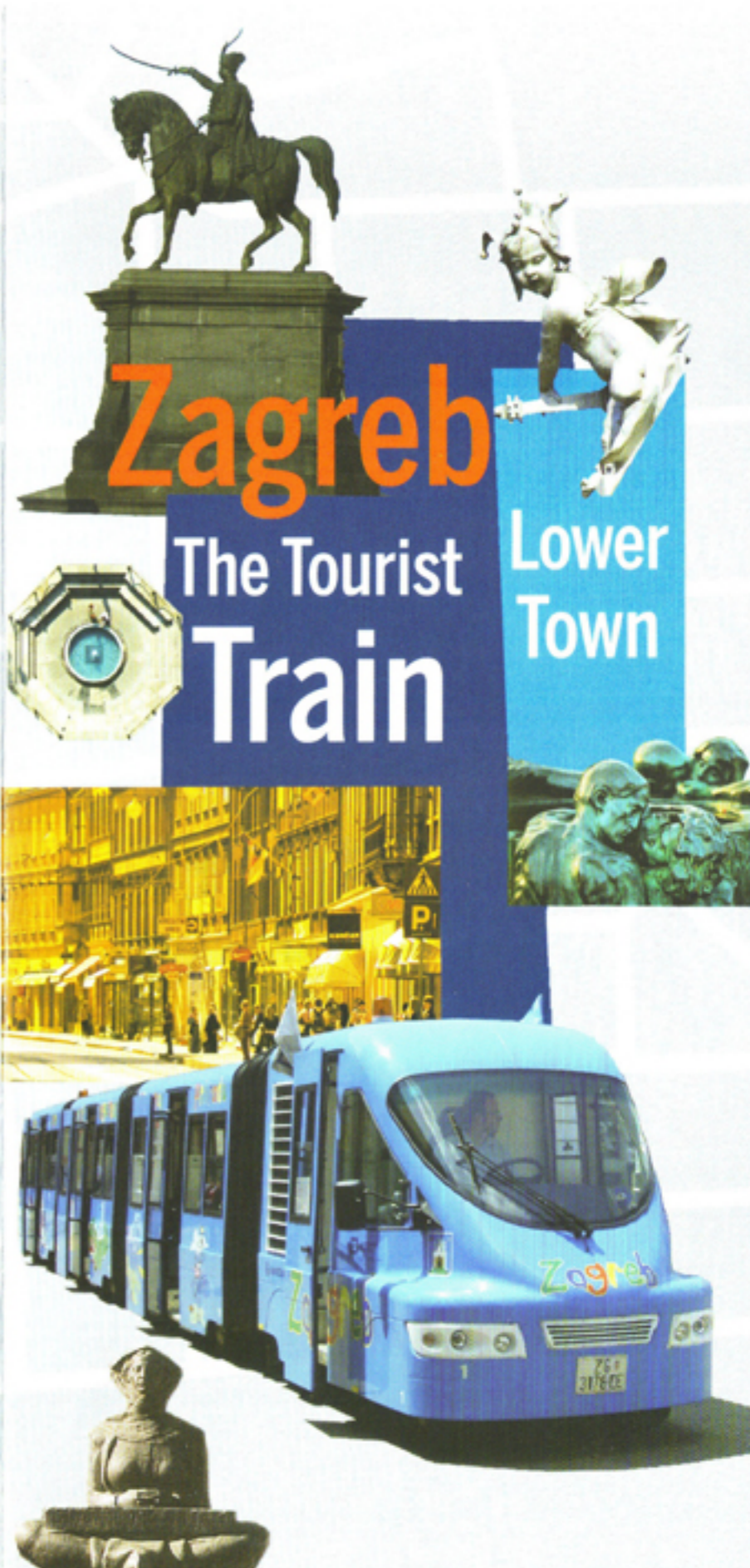

### Manduševac

Underneath the Manduševac fountain is a spring that provided water for Zagreb until the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. The spring was named after a beautiful girl called Manda who, according to legend, drew water from it and gave it to a boy returning from battle.

### Ban Josip Jelačić

The monument to the general and Croatian ban Josip Jelačić by the Austrian sculptor Fernikorn was erected in 1886.

### Funicular

Since 1890 a 66-metre long rail connects the Upper and Lower Town. This is the shortest funicular railway in the world.

In front of the Rectorate of the University of Zagreb stands the sculpture "History of the Croats" (*Povijest Hrvata*) by the sculptor Ivan Meštrović.

### Lotrščak Tower

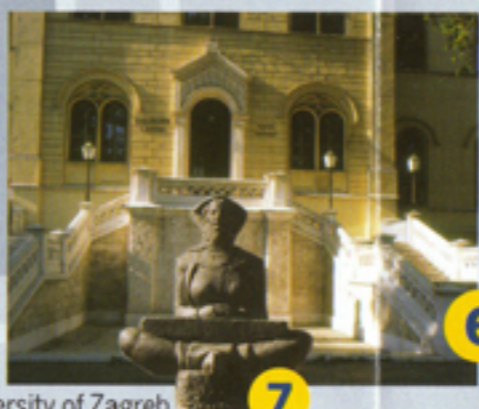
The only preserved tower of the mediaeval city fort dating from the 13<sup>th</sup> century. Every day since 1877, a canon fires at noon from the tower.

### Andrija Kačić Miošić

The monument to the mid-18<sup>th</sup> century Croatian friar, poet and educator Andrija Kačić Miošić, by the sculptor Ivan Rendić, was erected in 1891.

### Croatian National Theatre

The neo-Baroque building of the Croatian National Theatre was ceremoniously opened by the emperor Franz Joseph I in 1895.

### Zagreb University

The building now housing the Rectorate of the University of Zagreb was built in the mid-19<sup>th</sup> century.

### Well of Life

In front of the building of the Croatian National Theatre stands the sculpture "Well of Life" (*Zdenac života*) by the esteemed sculptor Ivan Meštrović.
